21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-10-701 is amended as follows:

24 24-10-701. Election to participate.

25 (a) In lieu of terminating employment and accepting a paid service
26 retirement benefit, a police officer or firefighter who is a member in paid
27 service with the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System ~~who has at~~
28 ~~least twenty-eight (28) years of service~~ may elect to participate in the
29 Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan and defer the receipt
30 of benefits in accordance with the provisions of this subchapter, provided
31 the member meets one (1) of the following requirements:

32 (1) The member has at least twenty-eight (28) years of service;

33 or

34 (2) The member has at least twenty (20) years of service and is
35 at least fifty-five (55) years of age.

36 (b) The Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire



1 Retirement System shall approve the participation in the plan.

2
3 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-10-703(c), pertaining to contributions,
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 (c)(1) ~~Seventy-five percent (75%)~~ For members that have at least
6 twenty-eight (28) years of service before electing to participate in the
7 Local Police and Fire Deferred Retirement Option Plan, seventy-five percent
8 (75%) of the member's monthly retirement benefit that would have been payable
9 had the member elected to cease employment and receive a service retirement
10 shall be paid into the members' plan account.

11 (2) For members that have at least twenty (20) but less than
12 twenty-eight (28) years of service and are at least fifty-five (55) years of
13 age before electing to participate in the Local Police and Fire Deferred
14 Retirement Option Plan, seventy-two percent (72%) of the member's monthly
15 retirement benefit that would have been payable had the member elected to
16 cease employment and receive a service retirement shall be paid into the
17 members' plan account.
