The Arkansas Youth Suicide Prevention Task Force shall:	
(1) Assist in increasing the awareness of youth suicide amon	<u>g</u>

teachers, counselors, and students to encourage everyone to recognize the	
signs of suicidal tendencies and other facts about youth suicide;
