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15 AN ACT CONCERNING BILLS REFERRED TO THE
16 JOINT COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC RETIREMENT AND
17 SOCIAL SECURITY PROGRAMS.

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-702(b)(3), concerning bills referred
23 to the Joint Committee on Public Retirement and Social Security Programs, is
24 amended to read as follows:

25 (3)(A) No bill amending an existing publicly supported
26 retirement system by increasing the multiplier, changing terms of or allowing
27 the purchase of credited service, shortening vesting periods or shortening
28 the years of service required for standard retirement without penalty, or
29 which would establish a new or expanded public retirement program, shall be
30 acted upon in either house until the fiscal note provided for in subsection
31 (a) of this section has been attached to the bill, ~~two-thirds (2/3) a~~
32 majority of the membership of the joint committee has recommended the passage
33 of the bill, and the joint committee has reported its recommendations in
34 regard to the bill.

35 (B) However, upon suspension of the Joint Rules of the
36 House of Representatives and Senate, a retirement system bill may be



1 withdrawn from further consideration by the joint committee and may be acted
2 upon without a report of the joint committee being attached thereto.

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
