Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AS A PUBLIC SAFETY OR LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER UNDER A MUNICIPAL POLICE OR FIRE PENSION FUND WHEN DETERMINING RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY UNDER THE ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

 AN ACT TO PROVIDE SERVICE CREDIT FOREMPLOYMENT AS A PUBLIC SAFETY OR LAW
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHEN DETERMINING
RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY UNDER THE
ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE
RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Title 24, Chapter 10, Subchapter 5 is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

24-10-511. Service credit.
(a) Any member of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System who has service credit for employment in the State of Arkansas as a public safety or law enforcement officer under a municipal police or municipal fire pension fund may receive credited service for that employment when determining retirement eligibility.
(b) The service credit granted under subsection (a) of this section shall not be considered as years of service for the purpose of benefit

calculation.
(c) In determining the amount of a benefit to be paid by the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System, there shall be used only the credited service under the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System and the benefit formula of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.
