21 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins, of Copperas Cove, Texas, and formerly of Green
22 Forest, Arkansas, died on August 15, 2004, in Najaf, Iraq, at the age of
23 twenty-three (23) years; and

25 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins was a second lieutenant in the United States Army,
26 serving with the First Cavalry Division in Iraq; and

28 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins was a 1999 graduate of Bonner Springs High School in
29 Bonner Springs, Kansas; was co-valedictorian of his graduating class; was
30 captain of the football and basketball squads; was on the all-conference team
31 of the Huron League; earned the football most valuable defensive player award
32 and the Sacrifice Award for basketball; received the Outstanding Industrial
33 Technology Student award and the Governor's Scholar award; was a member of
34 the Honor Society; was a National Merit Scholar; received the Academic
35 Excellence Award; was the Bonner Springs Rotary Club Outstanding Student, a
36 Kansas Honor Scholar, and a member of the Star Program; and

2 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins graduated from Kansas State University with a
3 bachelor of arts degree and received the Superior Cadet Decoration Award, the
4 National Society of Collegiate Scholars Award, and the National Military
5 Scholar Award; and

7 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins was a member of the First Baptist Church of Green
8 Forest, Arkansas, for many years prior to moving his membership to Rehms Park
9 Baptist Church in Bonner Springs, Kansas; and

11 WHEREAS, Lt. Goins is survived by his wife, Paula Mason Goins; his
12 parents, Tammy and Jim Goins of Oak Grove, Arkansas; two sisters, Mandy and
13 her husband, Nathan Kilbourn, and Sarah Goins, all of Oak Grove, Arkansas;
14 his paternal grandparents, Ruth and Jim Goins of Oak Grove, Arkansas; his
15 maternal grandparents, Janis and Charles DeLozier of Green Forest, Arkansas;
16 his mother-in-law, Cyndi, and her husband, Brett Baker, of Lees Summit,
17 Missouri; his father-in-law, Jerry Anderson of Bonner Springs, Kansas; two
18 aunts; an uncle; two grandmothers-in-law; two sisters-in-law; cousins; and a
19 host of other relatives and friends; and

21 WHEREAS, the Senate of the Eighty-fifth General Assembly wishes to
22 publicly recognize Lt. Goins' contributions to the United States Army and his
