23 October 19, 2004, at the age of eighty-two (82) years; and

25 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was born in Erbie, Arkansas, to Jenny and Clyde
26 Hickman, who precede him in death; and

28 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was a lifelong resident of Newton and Boone
29 counties and attended the Silver Valley Community Church; and

31 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was a World War II veteran and a Civilian Corps
32 Camp participant; and

34 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was retired from law enforcement and served Boone
35 County as sheriff from 1959-1968; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was a charter member and past president of the
2 Moose Lodge; was a life member of the Arkansas Sheriffs' Association; and was
3 past president and life member of the Harrison Roundup Club; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman was preceded in death by his daughter, Jackie Sue
6 Riggins; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Hickman is survived by his wife, Rena Hickman; his sons
9 and daughters-in-law, Barney and Jan Hickman, Danny and Mary Hickman, all of
10 Harrison, Arkansas; his former wife and mother of his children, Faye Hickman,
11 of Harrison; his stepdaughter and her husband, Ann and Ernie Woolley, of
12 Harrison; his stepson, Ray Brooks, of Harrison; seven (7) grandchildren;
13 twelve (12) great-grandchildren; and a host of other family and friends; and

15 WHEREAS, the Senate of the Eighty-fifth General Assembly of the State
16 of Arkansas wishes to publicly recognize Mr. Hickman's contributions to the
17 State of Arkansas and his local community,
