8	SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
9	DIRECTING THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD TO
10	ESTABLISH RULES REGARDING PERMITS AND TO CEASE
11	ISSUING PERMITS IN COUNTIES THAT PROHIBIT THE
12	MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

15	DIRECTING THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL
16	BOARD TO ESTABLISH RULES REGARDING
17	PERMITS AND TO CEASE ISSUING PERMITS IN
18	DRY COUNTIES.

21	WHEREAS, Act 132 of 1969 authorized the Alcoholic Beverage Control
22	Board to establish rules with respect to the issuance of permits to sell
23	alcoholic beverages in hotels, restaurants, and private clubs; and
24	
25	WHEREAS, in 1969 when Act 132 was passed, the General Assembly was
26	searching for ways to expand the economy; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, the 2000 census data indicated that "dry" counties in which it
29	is unlawful to manufacture or sell intoxicating liquor had a greater
30	population increase from 1990 to 2000 than did "wet" counties in which the
31	manufacture and sell of intoxicating liquor was lawful; and
32	
33	WHEREAS, this increase in population indicates a greater business and
34	industrial growth in the "dry" counties; and
35	
36	WHEREAS, this increase in population indicates that people are



preferring to live in "dry" counties; and WHEREAS, the census data indicates that the availability of alcohol is not as essential for economic growth as was earlier believed; and WHEREAS, the Alcohol Beverage Control Board has issued permits for the sale of alcohol in "dry" counties; and WHEREAS, considerable opposition has developed in many "dry" counties to the presence of alcohol permits; and WHEREAS, the presence of alcohol in "dry" counties appears to be in conflict with the will of the people in those counties as evidenced by the vote of the people that the county be "dry", NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN; That the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall establish rules with respect to permits for the sale of alcohol in "dry" counties so that the issuance of alcohol permits in "dry" counties will cease and recommendations that apply to changes requested to existing permits in "dry" counties will cease.
