11	his career, including an Army Commendation Medal for outstanding work with
12	poverty communities; a Distinguished Service Award from the Arthritis
13	Foundation; a Professional Award from the Arkansas Alliance for the Mentally
14	Ill; and the Social Work Pioneer Award from the Arkansas National Association
15	of Social Workers; and

18	has been a reservoir of knowledge and a respected colleague to his co-workers
