9	duration in even numbered years; unless by a vote of two-thirds three-fourths	
10	of the members elected to each house of said the General Assembly. Provided,	
11	that this section shall not apply to the first session of the General	
12	Assembly under this Constitution, or when impeachments are pending.

14	SECTION 3. This amendment becomes effective January 1, 2007.
