24	device detonated while he was on patrol; and

26	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles was assigned to the Army's 6th Squadron, 8th Cav.						
27	Reg., 4th Bde., 3rd Inf. Div., based at Fort Stewart, Georgia; and

29	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles, a native of Arkadelphia, Arkansas, graduated from						
30	Arkadelphia High School in 2004 and entered the Army in June 2004 as an						
31	indirect fire infantryman; and

33	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles had been in Iraq only a week, but his family,						
34	including his mother, Kim, his sisters, JoAnn and Jennifer, and his						
35	grandmothers, takes comfort in knowing that he died doing what he wanted to						
36	do, which was helping others; and

2	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles joined the military during a time of war knowing						
3	the ultimate sacrifice could be his life; and he wanted to help the people of						
4	Iraq because of the human rights violations that had occurred there under						
5	Saddam Hussein; and

7	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles was a strong, brave, compassionate, and courageous						
8	young man who, in response to his family's pleas to not join the military,						
9	said it would be better for him to go than for a man with a wife and						
10	children; and he had talked of his desire to make the military his career;						
11	and

13	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles was an outgoing, humorous, adventurous person, who						
14	was well-liked by classmates in school; enjoyed all kinds of sports,						
15	including baseball, football, soccer, golf, surfing, hiking, and						
16	snowboarding; loved the outdoors and hunting; and was a certified scuba						
17	diver; and

19	WHEREAS, Pvt. Giles is an American and an Arkansas hero who had a						
20	thirst for life and strong sense of duty; and						
21							
22	WHEREAS, the Senate of the Eighty-fifth General Assembly wishes to						
23	publicly recognize Pvt. Giles' contributions to the United States Army, the						
24	State of Arkansas, and his local community,

26	NOW THEREFORE,						
27	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE						
28	STATE OF ARKANSAS:
