For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ENSURE A GENERAL, SUITABLE, AND
10 EFFICIENT SYSTEM OF PUBLIC EDUCATION FOR STUDENTS
11 BY ADDRESSING ISSUES RAISED BY THE ARKANSAS
12 SUPREME COURT; TO ALLOW SCHOOL DISTRICTS WITH
13 MORE THAN ONE (1) HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS TO OFFER
14 CURRICULUM STANDARD REQUIREMENTS AT LESS THAN ALL
15 CAMPUSES IF ALL CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS ARE
16 READILY AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS AT ANOTHER CAMPUS
17 IN THE DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

28 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

30 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-103, regarding the course of study, is
31 amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

32 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, a
33 school district with more than one (1) high school campus shall not be
34 required to offer all of the curriculum standard requirements for secondary
35 public schools under the Standards of Accreditation for Arkansas Public
36 Schools at each campus if all curriculum requirements are readily available



1 to students at another campus in the district.
