SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 10 11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 13 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 18

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20 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 30 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 31 the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 32 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is 33 essential due to the call of the Governor for the convening of an Extraordinary Session, that the provisions of this Act will provide 34 35 necessary positions and monies for the Office of the Governor to provide essential governmental services for an Extraordinary Session, the delay in 36

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1	the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval
2	could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
3	essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
4	to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5	public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
6	after its passage and approval.
7	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
8	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
9	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
10	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
11	the veto.
