4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE	
5	STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

7	That the First Extraordinary Session of the Eighty-Fifth General	
8	Assembly of the State of Arkansas shall recess at the close of business on	
9	April 10, 2006, until 12:00 Noon on May 2, 2006, at which time it is adjoined	
10	sine die unless the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of	
11	the House of Representatives, by joint proclamation:	
12	(1) Reconvene the General Assembly at a time before 12:00 Noon, May 2,	
13	2006, for the purpose of considering vetoes, correcting errors, oversights,	
14	or omissions, and to clarify or otherwise revise those laws enacted prior to	
15	the recess, and to complete action on any and all other matters included in	
16	the Governor's proclamation calling the First Extraordinary Session of the	
17	Eighty-Fifth General Assembly; or	
18	(2) Adjourn the First Extraordinary Session of the Eighty-Fifth	
19	General Assembly at any time before that date if they determine it is not	
20	necessary to reconvene.
