19	WHEREAS, Dr. Jack Logan and Mr. Bert Alexander of Conway, Arkansas, are
20	believed to have died on Monday, April 3, 2006, while fishing in a Nicaraguan
21	lake; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, Dr. Logan, a dentist, and Mr. Alexander, a sales manager for a
24	pharmaceutical company and a member of the Conway Planning Commission, were
25	in Juigalpa, Nicaragua, on a missionary trip to teach at the Fellowship Bible
26	Church's Bible Training Institute; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Dr. Logan and Mr. Alexander had completed their week of work
29	in Nicaragua and stayed for some recreational fishing on Lake Nicaragua with
30	the local pastor and his wife and several others; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, a large wave struck the fishing boat, causing the boat to
33	capsize and washing all passengers into the lake; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, Dr. Logan and Mr. Alexander clung to a floating cooler along
36	with a 22-year-old boy and a 14-year-old boy but soon realized they could not



1	continue; and
2	
3	WHEREAS, Dr. Logan and Mr. Alexander spoke final words of encouragement
4	to the boys and pushed off the cooler, giving their own lives so that the
5	boys could live; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, the House of Representatives of the Eighty-Fifth General
8	Assembly wishes to publicly recognize Dr. Logan and Mr. Alexander for their
9	sacrifice,
10	
11	NOW THEREFORE,
12	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-FIFTH GENERAL
13	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
14	
15	THAT the House of Representatives recognizes Dr. Jack Logan and Mr.
16	Bert Alexander's sacrifice and commends them.
17	
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the individual members of the House of
19	Representatives hereby express sincere condolences to the family of Dr. Logan
20	and Mr. Alexander, and upon adoption of this resolution, an appropriate copy
