19 WHEREAS, the Pine Bluff Dollarway Cardinals avenged last season's  
20 semifinal loss to Little Rock Christian with a 60-54 victory to claim the  
21 Class AAA boys' state basketball championship; and

23 WHEREAS, Head Coach Ellis Berry stressed that the key to the state  
24 championship was discipline, free throw shooting, and defense, and his team  
25 responded by hitting seven (7) of nine (9) free throws in the fourth quarter  
26 of the championship game, and twelve (12) of seventeen (17) overall; and

28 WHEREAS, the Cardinals' outside shooting prevailed in the championship  
29 game, with the Cardinals hitting eight (8) of thirteen (13) shots from three-  
30 point range after hitting six (6) of eight (8) three-pointers in the first  
31 half; and

33 WHEREAS, the Cardinals jumped out to a 32-23 halftime lead behind the  
34 three-point shooting of Senior Co-captain Josh Bell, who finished the game  
35 with fourteen (14) points and hit both of his three-pointers in the first

WHEREAS, other members of the championship team are Devon Fountain, Chris Shorter, Matthew Price, Akemiah Roaf, Edwin Shorter, Justin Harris, Stacy Kimble, Webster Laws, Xavier Kirkland, Germane Clark, and Joseph Byrd,
