30	to pick up the pace, finding the team a little sluggish in the first half but
31	pleased with her well-conditioned team's second-half effort; and

33	WHEREAS, the Lady Bulldogs won with balance, getting 14 points from
34	sophomore Jasmine Canser, 12 points from senior Alexis Johnson, 11 points
35	from junior Miranda Parker, and nine points and eight assists from sophomore
36	Destiny Rogers; and

3	second consecutive 35-1 season, with the Lady Bulldogs going undefeated in
4	Class AA play since losing to Hampton in the 2004 Region Eight tournament;

8	losses have come against West Monroe, Louisiana, during the 2004-2005 season
9	and at Mountain Home in December, 2005; and
