20 WHEREAS, Brittany Johnson's outstanding rebounding effort in the second
21 half carried the Strong Lady Bulldogs to their second consecutive Class AA
22 girls' state basketball championship title; and

25 valuable player, scored a game-high 17 points and grabbed 17 rebounds as the
26 Lady Bulldogs pulled away from East Poinsett County in the second half for a
27 70-49 victory; and

29 WHEREAS, the team responded to Coach Kendrah Ferguson's halftime urging
30 to pick up the pace, finding the team a little sluggish in the first half but
31 pleased with her well-conditioned team's second-half effort; and

33 WHEREAS, the Lady Bulldogs won with balance, getting 14 points from
34 sophomore Jasmine Canser, 12 points from senior Alexis Johnson, 11 points
35 from junior Miranda Parker, and nine points and eight assists from sophomore
36 Destiny Rogers; and
