20	WHEREAS, record-setting senior quarterback Mitch Mustain led the
21	undefeated Springdale Bulldogs to the Class AAAAA state high school football
22	championship by completing 17 of 28 passes for 344 yards and five touchdowns;
23	and

25	WHEREAS, in the championship game, Mitch Mustain threw touchdown passes
26	of 53, 32, and 10 yards to senior wide receiver Damien Williams, 59 yards to
27	senior wide receiver Andrew Norman, and ten yards to senior running back
28	Victor Pongonis; and

30	WHEREAS, Mitch Mustain was instrumental in the 14-0 Bulldog's record-
31	setting highest point total for a Class AAAAA state championship game, 54-20
32	over West Memphis, and in achieving a postseason scoring record of 196 points
33	in four games; and

35	WHEREAS, Mitch Mustain was named the national Parade Magazine All-
36	American Player of the Year, the Gatorade National Player of the Year, and

1	the USA Today Offensive Player of the Year, the three major national high
2	school football awards for individual offensive players; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, Mitch Mustain is the only player to not only receive all three
5	of the major national awards, but also to receive the three awards in the
6 7	same year; and
8	WHEREAS, the 6'3", 204-pound senior quarterback has accepted a
9	scholarship to play football for the University of Arkansas Razorbacks; and
10	denotationary to play rootball for the university of minamous nazorbacks, and
11	WHEREAS, during the past season Mitch Mustain achieved individual
12	Springdale Bulldog team records of 190 completions, 3,817 passing yards, 47
13	touchdowns, and 6 touchdowns in a single game; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, during his Springdale High School football career, Mitch
16	Mustain achieved team records of 67 touchdown passes, 5,986 passing yards,
17	329 completions, and 492 career passing attempts; and

19	WHEREAS, academically, Mitch Mustain is a "B" student who scored a 26
20	on the ACT college entrance exam, is a member of the Fellowship of Christian
21	Athletes, and is a youth leader at the First Baptist Church speaking to
22	students at local elementary and middle schools about the importance of
23	character,
