## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE GROSS
RECEIPTS AND COMPENSATING USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR THE SALE OF A USED MOTOR VEHICLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-52-510(b)(l)(B), regarding the exemption from gross receipts tax for the sale of used motor vehicles, is amended to read as follows:
(B) However, if the total consideration for the sale of the new or used motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer is less than two thousand five hundred dollars $(\$ 2,500)$ five thousand dollars $(\$ 5,000)$, no tax shall be due.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 26-53-126(b)(2), regarding the exemption from compensating use tax for the sale of used motor vehicles, is amended to read as follows:
(2) However, if the total consideration for the sale of the new or used motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer is less than two thousand five


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hundred dollars \((\$ 2,500)\) five thousand dollars \((\$ 5,000)\), no tax shall be due.
SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall apply to the sale of a new or used motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer that occurs on or after the first day of the calendar month following the effective date of this act.
hundred dollars ($2,500) five thousand dollars ($5,000), no tax shall be due.
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
