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1	(b)(1) A person convicted of a felony or a Class A misdemeanor shall		
2	be assessed a booking and administration fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00).		
3	(2)(A) The booking and administration fee described in

18	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
19	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that county jails and regional		
20	detention facilities in this state lack sufficient operating funds; that the		
21	revenue derived as a result of this act will be used exclusively for the		
22	maintenance, operation, and capital expenditures of county jails and regional		
23	detention facilities, and that this act is necessary because the immediate		
24	collection of booking and administration fees will enable county jails and		
25	regional detention facilities to expedite efforts to increase the efficient		
26	administration of justice. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and		
27	this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,		
28	and safety shall become effective on:		
29	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
30	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
31	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
32	bill; or		
33	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
34	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
