19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 7 is amended to add an
22 additional subchapter to read as follows:

23 20-7-501. Title.

24 This subchapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Arkansas
25 Health-Conscious Shopper Act".

27 20-7-502. Findings – Intent.

28 (a) The General Assembly finds that shopping cart handles may be
29 contaminated with bodily fluids such as blood, saliva, mucus, and even urine
30 and fecal matter.

31 (b) This subchapter is intended to:

32 (1) Protect Arkansas shoppers, infants, and young children from
33 potential contamination from contact with by a shopping cart handle;

34 (2) Provide a barrier of protection between a shopper and a
35 shopping cart handle; and

36 (3) Prevent the spread of viruses or bacteria.

20-7-503. Arkansas Health-Conscious Shopper Program.

(a) There is created the Arkansas Health-Conscious Shopper Program.

(b) Under the program, each Arkansas business that uses shopping carts or infant carriers is encouraged to voluntarily provide consumers with sanitation wipes at the entrance of its business on or before January 1, 2008.

20-7-504. State Board of Health – Rules.

The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules to provide guidance for businesses in the appropriate types and use of sanitation wipes for shopping cart handles.
