LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AND TO REMOVE
OBSOLETE LANGUAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-303(d), concerning the duties of the
Bureau of Legislative Research, is amended to read as follows:

(d) The agenda of each session of the Legislative Council shall be
prepared by the director, ~~who shall be assisted by the Dean of the School of
Law of the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville~~ under the direction of the
cochairs of the Legislative Council, and the agenda shall consist of any
proposals as may be submitted by the members of the General Assembly, the
Governor of the State of Arkansas, and such other matters as may be suggested
by matters of public interest.
