8 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 29 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to 30 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and 31 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential 32 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the 33 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the 34 35 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper

36 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,

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1	an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
2	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
3	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
4	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
5	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
6	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
7	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
8	the veto.
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
