7	7 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement	t of funds authorized	
8	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds		
9	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the		
10	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
11	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
12	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal		
13	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

17	7 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of	the General Assembly

21	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

23	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or		
24	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26	6 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determ	mined by the General	
27	Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly	for the operations of	
28	8 <u>the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement System are, d</u>	ue to unforeseen	
29	circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Public Employees Retirement		
30	System to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the		
31	provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas		
32	Public Employees Retirement System to continue such services; and that a		
33	delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the		
34	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.		
35	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
36	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
