8 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Board of 9 Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, 10 11 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such 12 purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of 13 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and 14 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate 15 classification.

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17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 18 the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, to be 19 payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Board of 20 Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, for personal services 21 and operating expenses of the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology 22 and Audiology for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following: 23

1 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 3 4 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 20 21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 25 26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 31 32 33

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
