10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE BOARD OF  
11 EXAMINERS IN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY AND  
12 AUDIOLOGY FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,  
13 2009; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Board of  
26 Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for the 2007-2009  
27 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries  
28 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
29 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and  
30 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
31 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
32 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
33 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
34 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
35 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology, for personal services and operating expenses of the Board of Examiners in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

1 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 4 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 5 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 6 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 7 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 8 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 9 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

 11 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 18 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

 20 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 21 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 22 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
 24 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 25 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
 26 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
 27 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
 28 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
 29 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
 30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
