SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CLAIMS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State Claims Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous

1 Revolving Fund, for payment of claims awarded to surviving spouses and/or 2 dependent children of deceased policemen, firemen, correctional officers and other specified state employees killed in the official line of duty, as 3 4 prescribed by law; for payment of small controversial claim awards made by 5 the Arkansas State Claims Commission; and for payment of awards made by the 6 Arkansas State Claims Commission, as provided by law, on non-controversial 7 claims, for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following: 8 9 ITEM FISCAL YEARS 10 NO. 2007-2008 2008-2009 11 CLAIMS FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES/DEPENDENT (01)12 CHILDREN, SMALL CONTROVERSIAL CLAIMS AND SMALL NON-CONTROVERSIAL CLAIMS 1,500,000 \$ 1,500,000 13 14 15 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act 18 19 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an 20 21 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 22 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and 23 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due 24 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through 25 the State Mechanized Payroll System. 26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005 27 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 28 29 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 31 32 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

1	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
2	
3	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
5	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
6	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
7	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
9	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
10	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
11	
12	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
19	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
