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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 1(E) of Act 619 of 2005 is amended to
26 read as follows:

27 (E) For state assistance to the ~~Fargo~~ Maddox Bay Fire Department, the
28 sum of\$5,000.
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30 SECTION 2. As referenced in Section 3 of Act 2315 of the Regular
31 Session, 85th General Assembly, which identifies the Fargo Fire Department as
32 a project to be funded from the 85th Session Projects Account of the General
33 Improvement Fund, shall instead be deemed to be the Maddox Bay Fire
34 Department.
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36 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor



1 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
 2 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
 3 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
 4 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
 5 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
 6 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
 7 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
 8 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
 9 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
 10 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
 11 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

12 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
 13 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
 14 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
 15 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
 16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
 17 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
 18 otherwise by law.

 20 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 21 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 22 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 23 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 24 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 25 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 26 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 27 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 29 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 30 General Assembly, that the Maddox Bay Fire Department was not included in the
 31 General Improvement Distribution Act of 2005; that funds had been set aside
 32 for this project but the project had been inadvertently identified as the
 33 Fargo Fire Department, which was closed down and is no longer in operation;
 34 that to provide funding for the appropriation for the Maddox Bay Fire
 35 Department authorized by Section 1 of Act 619 of 2005 the passage of this Act
 36 is necessary. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this

1 act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
2 health, and safety shall become effective on:

3 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

4 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the
5 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;
6 or

7 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden,
8 the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
