## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to CLARIFY the Law on Child Support
ARREARAGES OWED BY A NONBIOLOGICAL FATHER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-10-115(f), concerning child support obligations, is amended to read as follows:
(f)(l) If the test administered under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this section excludes the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity as the biological father of the child and the court so finds, the court shall:
(A) setSet aside the previous finding or establishment of paternity and;
(B) relieve him Relieve the man of any future obligation of support as of the date of the finding-; and
(C) Order that any unpaid support is satisfied that was due prior to the date the order that states the adjudicated father or selfacknowledged father is in fact not the biological father of the child.
(2) If the name of the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity appears on the birth certificate of the child, the court shall issue an order requiring the birth
certificate to be amended to delete the name of the father.
