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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-10-115(f), concerning child support
22 obligations, is amended to read as follows:

23 (f)(1) If the test administered under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this
24 section excludes the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father
25 pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity as the biological father of the
26 child and the court so finds, the court shall:

27 (A) set~~set~~ aside the previous finding or establishment of
28 paternity ~~and~~;

29 (B) relieve him ~~Relieve the man~~ of any future obligation
30 of support as of the date of the finding~~+~~; and

31 (C) Order that any unpaid support is satisfied that was
32 due prior to the date the order that states the adjudicated father or self-
33 acknowledged father is in fact not the biological father of the child.

34 (2) If the name of the adjudicated father or man deemed to be
35 the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity appears on the birth
36 certificate of the child, the court shall issue an order requiring the birth



1 certificate to be amended to delete the name of the father.

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
