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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-10-115(f), concerning child support
22 obligations, is amended to read as follows:

23 (f)(1) If the test administered under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this
24 section excludes the adjudicated father or man deemed to be the father
25 pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity as the biological father of the
26 child and the court so finds, the court shall:

27 (A) setSet aside the previous finding or establishment of
28 paternity ~~and~~;

29 (B) Find that there is no future obligation of support;

30 (C) Order that any unpaid support owed under the previous
31 order is vacated; and

32 (D) Order that any support previously paid is not subject
33 to refund

34 (2) If the name of the adjudicated father or man deemed to be
35 the father pursuant to an acknowledgment of paternity appears on the birth
36 certificate of the child, the court shall issue an order requiring the birth



1 certificate to be amended to delete the name of the father.
