21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Bank Department for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of
25 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

19 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Bank
 20 Department for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-
 21 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 22 appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time
 23 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 24 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 25 for the appropriate classification.

27 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 28 the State Bank Department, to be payable from the Bank Department Fund, for
 29 personal services and operating expenses of the State Bank Department for the
 30 biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

9 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
 11 RATES OF PAY. Due to the highly competitive job market conditions for banking
 12 industry professionals and the necessity of recruiting and retaining
 13 qualified personnel, the State Bank Department is authorized special rates of
 14 pay for current and new employees up to the levels listed under subsection
 15 (a), with additional authority and restrictions as indicated in subsections
 16 (b) and (c) below:

17 (a) Special rates may be authorized for the following classifications
 18 only, as indicated herein.

28 (b) Applications for special rates of pay indicated in subsection (a) shall
 29 have been reviewed and approved by the Office of Personnel Management after
 30 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council.

31 (c) Labor market rates will be established as needed for classifications
 32 not covered by the provisions of this section.

33 (d) A current plan of progression should be filed with the Office of
 34 Personnel Management on a biennial basis.

35 This special provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium
 36 beginning July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007 and ending June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
