SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)

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1 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

2 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its

3 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby

6 appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable

- 7 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas
- 8 Development Finance Authority, for personal services and operating expenses

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SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized in the HUD Home Program of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006 2008 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2007 2009.

Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

- 1 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
- 2 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding
- 3 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 4 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 5 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
- 6 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
- 7 <u>biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget</u>
- 8 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which
- 9 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
- 10 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
- 11 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
- 12 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
- 13 set forth in (1) above;
- 14 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 15 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 16 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 17 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 18 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 19 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 20 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 21 Committee; and
- 22 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 23 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
- 24 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 25 <u>Institution</u>.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{1}$
- 27 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

- 29 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME
- 31 PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in the HUD Home
- 32 Program of this Act shall be in accordance with the State of Arkansas
- 33 Consolidated Plan developed and administered in part by the Arkansas
- 34 Development Finance Authority and shall be in accordance with project
- 35 requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban
- 36 Development HOME Program.

1	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{1}$
2	2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

4	SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
5	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
6	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
7	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
13	
14	SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
21	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
22	
23	SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
25	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
26	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
27	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
29	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
30	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
31	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
32	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
33	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
