- 1 and/or programs make it necessary that the Arkansas Public Service Commission 2 - Tax Division receives additional appropriations to carry out the objectives of the Division, the Chairman of the Arkansas Public Service Commission is 3 4 hereby authorized to request the approval of the Governor and the Chief 5 Fiscal Officer of the State for transfers of the appropriations provided in 6 the Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act to 7 other line items within the Tax Division appropriation. In no event shall 8 the transfers in any fiscal year exceed the appropriations provided in the 9 Contingency line item of the Tax Division appropriation of this Act. The Governor may approve or modify such request for transfer of appropriations as 10 11 in his or her judgment he or she deems necessary, and shall seek prior review 12 and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council and inform the Chief Fiscal 13 Officer of the State. Upon notification, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 14 State shall direct the State Auditor to process said transfer upon his or her 15 books in accordance with the provisions as set out herein. 16 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 17 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 18 19 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 20 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 21 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 22 has determined that the Public Service Commission - Tax Division may operate 23 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Public Service 24 Commission - Tax Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly 25 26 maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or 27 Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of 28 approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a 29 severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the 30 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 31
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2005}{2007}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2007}{2009}$ .

35 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS

1 UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND. To ensure that telecommunications rates are 2 reasonable and affordable, the Arkansas Public Service Commission should take 3 all reasonable steps necessary to maintain and reduce the Arkansas Universal 4 Service Fund (AUSF), administrative expenses and avoid mandating changes any 5 additional charges or expenses in for telecommunications services that could 6 increase AUSF assessments which would result in higher AUSF surcharges to 7 customers. 8 9 SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 12 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 13 14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 17 18 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 27 28 SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
