The appropriation authorized in this Act for Honoring 3 4 Arkansas' War Heroes is authorized for the 2007-2009 biennium only and is not 5 intended to be carried forward into the base level for the purposes of 6 biennial budget preparation for the 2009-2011 biennium. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.
