27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

29 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-301(a)(3)(B), concerning the
30 membership of the Legislative Council is amended to add additional
31 subdivisions to read as follows:

32 (vii) If the House cochair of the Legislative Joint
33 Auditing Committee has not been elected, the Speaker of the House of
34 Representatives may appoint a member of the House to serve until the House
35 members of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee elect a cochair of the
36 Legislative Joint Auditing Committee.
