11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Board of 12 Registration for Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors for the 2007-2009 13 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, 14 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such 15 purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of 16 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and 17 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate 18 classification.

20 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 21 the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Land 22 Surveyors, to be payable from the cash fund deposited in the State Treasury 23 as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services 24 and operating expenses of the State Board of Registration for Professional 25 Engineers and Land Surveyors for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, 26 the following:

5 SECTION 4. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 6 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 7 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 8 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 9 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 10 11 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 12 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 13 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if: 14 15 The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such (1)

17 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the18 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

25 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 31 32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

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1 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 2 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 3 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 4 5 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 6 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 7 8 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 10 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 12 13 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 14 15 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 16 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 17 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 18 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27

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
