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- 33 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
  34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
  35 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds generated by fees and fines pursuant
- 36 to Arkansas Code 20-8-103 et. seq. deposited into the Miscellaneous Agencies

- 1 Fund Account which remain at the close of each state fiscal year shall be
- 2 carried forward to the next state fiscal year to be used for the same intent
- 3 and purposes as set forth in law.
- 4 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as
- 5 <u>authorized herein</u>, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
- 6 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
- 7 <u>its reason(s)</u> for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding
- 8 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

- 20 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee

- 22 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
- 23 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)

- 34 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 35 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 36 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

1 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 7 8 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 18 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 19 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
