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     of this provision, has been removed from membership in the Arkansas Public
     Employees' Retirement System because of eligibility for membership in a local
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1 firemen's pension fund as a volunteer firefighter may restore the refunded 2 service and establish subsequent service by paying or causing to be paid to the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System the refunded contributions 3 4 and the legally required contributions for subsequent service. 5 (B) Excepting members of the General Assembly and those 6 persons participating in a local firemen's pension fund because of their 7 status as volunteer firefighters and those persons who have dual full-time 8 employment in separate positions covered by the Arkansas Public Employees' 9 Retirement System and the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System 10 respectively, "employees" does not include persons who are members of any 11 other retirement system, excepting federal Social Security, which retirement 12 system is supported by state funds or is authorized by the laws of the state. 13 In addition, "employees" specifically does not include the following: 14 (i) Persons in the employ of the Department of 15 Arkansas State Police who are members of the State Police Retirement System; 16 (ii) Persons in the employ of the Department of 17 Education or the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, except as otherwise 18 provided by law; 19 (iii) Persons in the employ of the University of 20 Arkansas or any other state-supported institution of higher learning, except 21 as otherwise provided by law; 22 (iv) Justices of the Supreme Court, judges of 23 circuit courts, or judges of chancery courts; 24 (v) Persons in the employ of the General Assembly 25 who are employed on a less than full-time regular annual salary basis, except 26 that any person who has served or who shall serve during at least six (6) 27 legislative sessions as Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives and who 28 has served in the employ of the General Assembly during at least twelve (12) 29 previous legislative sessions shall be eligible to receive credited service 30 in the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System for any period of employment with the General Assembly since July 1, 1957, but only if the 31 32 employee is, or was, an active member of the system Arkansas Public 33 Employees' Retirement System with at least ten (10) years of credited service 34 and only if the employee pays or causes to be paid all employee contributions 35 at the rate and on the compensation that would have been paid had he or she

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4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 24, Chapter 4, Subchapter 7 is amended		
5	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
6	24-4-750. Purchase of service as a city alderman.		
7	(a) A member who has been elected to serve as a city alderman for a		
8	participating public employer may purchase credited service for his or her		
9	service as a city alderman if:		
10	(1) The member has at least five (5) years of credited service		
11	at the time of application;		
12	(2) The member received compensation for his or her service as a		
13	city alderman in excess of reimbursement for actual expenses; and		
14	(3) The member pays to the member's deposit fund an amount equal		
15	to the actuarial present value of the credited service provided for under		
16	this section based upon assumptions recommended by the actuary.		
17	(b) A member shall not receive the credited service provided under		
18	this section if the service is also used to establish entitlement to or the		
19	amount of any other benefit to be paid by any federal, state, or local		
20	governmental entity, except a benefit under the federal Social Security Act.		
21	(c) The credited service provided under this section is subject to any		
22	applicable limits under the Internal Revenue Code of 1987, as it existed on		
23	January 1, 2007.		
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
