4	SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS					
5	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA					
6	HELP RESTRICTION. No extra help employee of Disability Determination for					
7	Social Security Administration shall be employed for a period of time to					
8	exceed eighteen hundred (1800) hours in any single fiscal year.					
9	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2005}{1}$					
10	2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

12	SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE					
13	NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.					
14	The remaining balance as of June 30, $\frac{2006}{2008}$, of unexpended appropriation					
15	in Capital Outlay shall be carried forward into fiscal year 2006-07 <u>2008-09</u>					
16	to be used for the same purpose for the next fiscal year.					
17	Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as					
18	authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:					
19	(1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth					
20	its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding					
21	to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;					
22	(2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall					
23	report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from					
24	the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the					
25	biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget

27	report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution					
28	and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the					
29	first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,					
30	the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request					
31	set forth in (1) above;					
32	(3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written					
33	report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee					
34	containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written					
35	statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for					
36	which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)					

- l days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 2 <u>its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget</u>
- 3 Committee; and
- 4 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 5 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals

- 11 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 14 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 21 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

29

- 30 <u>SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General
- 31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
- 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the

1	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
2	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
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
