14 PRIVATE PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-412 is amended to read as follows:

27 8-6-412. Enforcement generally.

28 (a) All Arkansas-certified law enforcement officers:

29 (1) Shall enforce ~~the provisions of~~ this subchapter;

30 (2) ~~Are empowered to~~ May issue citations to or arrest persons
31 violating any provision of this subchapter; and

32 (3)(A) May serve and execute all warrants, citations, and other
33 process issued by the courts in enforcing ~~the provisions of~~ this subchapter.

34 (B) In addition, mailing by registered mail of the process
35 to the person's last known place of residence shall be deemed as personal
36 service upon the person charged.



1 (b)(1) Illegal dumps control officers licensed and certified in
2 accordance with § 8-6-905 and code enforcement officers as defined by
3 municipal ordinance may:

4 (A) ~~May enforce the provisions of~~ Enforce this subchapter;
5 and

6 (B) ~~Are empowered to issue~~ Issue citations to persons
7 violating this subchapter.

8 (2) However, illegal dumps control officers licensed and
9 certified in accordance with § 8-6-905 and code enforcement officers as
10 defined by municipal ordinance may shall not:

11 (A) Have the powers of arrest;

12 (B) Carry firearms; or

13 (C) Take any other official law enforcement actions.

14 (c)(1) All certified law enforcement officers may serve and execute
15 all warrants, citations, and other process issued by the courts in enforcing
16 ~~the provisions of~~ this subchapter.

17 (2) In addition, mailing by registered mail of the process to
18 the person's last known place of residence shall be deemed as personal
19 service upon the person charged.
