> AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-50-1205 TO GIVE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS THE POWER TO TAG VEHICLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-501205 TO GIVE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS THE POWER TO TAG VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-50-1205 is amended to read as follows: 27-50-1205. Tagging.
Any law enforcement officer or code enforcement officer as defined by municipal ordinance observing a vehicle on or near a public way which appears to be unattended or abandoned shall:
(1) Order immediate removal of any unattended, abandoned, disabled, or inoperative vehicle located within three feet (3') of the traveled surface of a public way or which vehicle appears to create a hazard to the public and shall log the removal order accordingly;
(2) Tag any unattended, abandoned, disabled, or inoperative vehicle located at a distance of three feet (3') or more by affixing securely a colored form or other easily observable sticker. The tag or sticker shall show:
(A) The date and time of tagging;
(B) That the vehicle will be removed pursuant to this subchapter unless the vehicle is removed within twenty-four (24) hours;
(C) The location and telephone number where more information may be obtained; and (D) The identification of the officer.
