21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-7-708(f), concerning waivers of the			
22	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System earnings limitation, is amended to read as			
23	follows:			
24	(f)(l) In accordance with rules and regulations adopted by the State			
25	Board of Education, the Department of Education may request of the board of			
26	trustees or its designee a waiver of the conditions subjecting annuities to			
27	limitations. If approved by the board of trustees or its designee, the waiver			
28	shall be effective for a one-year period, with the option to renew annually			
29	for up to a total of three (3) years as requested by the department.			
30		(2) A waiver of the conditions subjecting annuities to		
31	limitations may be requested if the retirant a retirant with at least thirty			
32	(30) years of credited service at the time of retirement is hired by a public			
33	school district due to a shortage of certified teachers in a critical

(4) School districts shall maintain audit files identifying personnel granted a waiver and documenting the reasons for the waiver. (5) Beginning July 1, 2005, for any retired member employed in a position covered by the system pursuant to a waiver, the employer and employee contribution rate to the system on behalf of the member shall recommence at the rate in effect at the time of the employment and shall be remitted by the employer. SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current laws applicable to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System regarding waivers of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System earnings limitation require revision; that revisions are necessary to ensure the effective and efficient operation of the system; and that the most effective time to make changes to the retirement system is at the beginning of the state's fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
