- Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
- 3 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
 4 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
 5 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
 6 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,

10 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 19 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Hot Springs Village Volunteer Fire Department was not 20 21 included in the General Improvement Distribution Act of 2005; that funds had 22 been set aside for this project but the project had been inadvertently 23 identified as the Hot Springs Village Property Owners Association; that to 24 provide funding for the appropriation for the Hot Springs Village Volunteer 25 Fire Department authorized by Section 1 of Act 1439 of 2005 the passage of 26 this Act is necessary. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 27 and this Act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public 28 peace, health and safety shall become effective on:
 - (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- 30 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the
 31 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;
 32 or
- 33 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
