made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 19 20 the Office of the Governor are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient 21 for the Office of the Governor to continue to provide essential governmental 22 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies 23 for the Office of the Governor to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper 24 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 25 26 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 27 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 28 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 29 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 30 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 31 32 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 33 the veto. 34 35 /s/ Joint Budget Committee

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
