23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
26 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the 2007-
27 2009 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
28 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification
29 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,
30 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to
31 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be
32 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation
33 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed
34 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act
35 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty-seven (27) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

 23 HELP - DOG RACING. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Finance
 24 and Administration - Division of Racing - Dog Racing, for the ~~2005-2007~~

 26 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 27 appropriated herein for such purposes, such employees shall be authorized to

 9 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RACING
 11 PASS RESTRICTIONS. The Director of the Department of Finance and
 12 Administration shall set a maximum number of racing passes to be printed and
 13 issued annually and it shall not be less than the number printed in 1990. The
 14 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007
 15 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

 17 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 19 CONVERSION OF EXTRA HELP EMPLOYEES - RACING DIVISION. Incumbents (employees)
 20 of the DFA Racing Division who occupy positions classified as "Extra Help"
 21 whose positions are terminated as of June 30, 2007, and who will be employed
 22 in new "Regular" classified positions as authorized by the General Assembly
 23 on July 1, 2007, shall be adjusted into the "Regular" positions at the hourly
 24 rates of pay they were receiving as of June 30, 2007 plus any additional
 25 compensation authorized by the General Assembly for Classified State
 26 Employees.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
 28 through June 30, 2009.

29
 30 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
2 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

3
4 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12
13 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
18 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
19 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
