(f) Except for service credit under § 24-7-602(e), service credit in the Arkansas National Guard or in a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States shall not be given if the service is credited under any other retirement plan, including a federal military retirement. SECTION 2. The purpose of this act is to address disparities in the allowance of purchasing service credit in state retirement systems for members of the Armed Forces Reserves and the Arkansas National Guard.
