19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 28-65-218(f), pertaining to hearings for  
22 temporary guardianships, is amended to read as follows:

23 (f)(1) Within ~~Except as provided in subdivision (f)(2) of this~~  
24 section, within three (3) working days of the entry of the temporary  
25 guardianship order, a full hearing on the merits shall be held.

26 (2) The court may waive the full hearing on the merits if the  
27 court finds that there are no justiciable issues of both law and fact.
