21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 28-65-218(f), pertaining to hearings for
24 temporary guardianships, is amended to read as follows:

25 (f)(1) ~~Within~~ Except as provided in subdivision (f)(2) of this
26 section, within three (3) working days of the entry of the temporary
27 guardianship order, a full hearing on the merits shall be held.

28 (2) The court may extend the time during which the full hearing
29 on the merits must be held upon a finding that extenuating circumstances
30 exist.
