(2) Upon reemployment and completion of credited service required to meet the minimum conditions of participation in the plan, the reemployed retirant may elect to participate in the plan. (3) If reemployment terminates before the end of the fiscal year in which a former retirant has worked at least three (3) years, then the former retirant shall: (A) Become a retired member, and the payment of the annuity at the time of recission shall resume upon the termination; (B) Be entitled to receive any member contributions that may have been made during the reemployment period; and (C) Forfeit any accumulated funds in the plan. (4) If the former retirant's reemployment terminates after the end of the fiscal year in which the former retirant has accumulated at least three (3) years of credited actual service, then upon termination of reemployment the former retirant shall become a retired member and receive an annuity along with any funds accumulated while participating in the plan.
